Boogie Night 2006

Welcome to Boogie Night 2006 dance camp to Tampere!

The biggest dance camp in Finland gathers again hundreds of dancers all over the world from 27th of December 2005 until 1st of January 2006. Get your dance shoes ready for unforgettable experiences with new friends and world-class instructors. Boogie Woogie is the main dance of the camp, but also Lindy Hop dancers get their part of the camp during the first two days. There are also tasters of several other dances during the camp.

Boogie Night is best known of its open and homely atmosphere. The evening parties gather the camp together, and provide with some common fun... They are continued in the dimly lit Boogie Nightclub, which has an atmosphere you must experience. There will be a chance for you to get familiar with Finnish dancing culture and all its various types of dances. We'll also have a live band - Atomic Boogie Band - playing and entertaining us on Thursday evening. Further information and instructions about the Night parties are below in this letter.

Campsite

Boogie Night 2006 –dance camp is organised in Finland, in the city of Tampere (about 180 kilometers north of the capital Helsinki) at Hervannan Vapaa-aikakeskus, addr: Lindforsinkatu 5, FIN-33720 Tampere. The airport is only 20 kilometers away and also other connections (train, bus etc.) are within easy reach.

The campsite has plenty of space for training (mirrors and wooden floors in most of the halls) and night parties. For floor-level accommodation at the campsite there are several classrooms in different sizes. The campsite has a number of shower rooms, dressing rooms and toilets for the participants. There are separate areas for eating and also the campsite cafeteria is open several times during the days.

Entrance to the campsite is through the second floor main door only. When you check in to the camp, you'll get a BN06-pass, which allows you to be at the camp site area. Keep the pass along with you for the whole time you stay.

Schedule of the camp

THE CAMP BEGINS	On Tuesday 27th December at 08.00 am, as the doors are opened to campers.
PRE-ACCOMMODATION	There is no pre-accommodation at the campsite. The campsite is opened on Tuesday 27th December 2005 at 08.00 am.
THE CAMP ENDS	On Sunday 1st January 2006 at 06.00 pm. The campsite is closed at 07.00 pm.

The first action as arriving to the campsite is to check in to the camp at the registration point taking place on the 2nd floor of the leisure center. Accommodating happens after that.

- Notice different schedules on the competition day Friday 30.12.2005 and on the closing day Sunday 1.1.2006.
- For each two-day period some new participants arrive at the Boogie Night 2006 –dance camp. Group level forming for all the new participants is on the arrival day at 11.00.
- The campsite is open on camp days between 8.00 and 24.00. In the nighttime you can enter by calling to the camp cell phone, tel. +358 50 541 8392.

Check-in and payment at the campsite

1. When you arrive at the campsite, first check in at the reception in the second floor of the camp building. Follow the registration instructions at the campsite.
2. Camp fee is paid in cash (euros) during the check in. You'll have to pay for the whole camp, all the meals and accommodation at the same time.
3. After check-in, you can find yourself an accommodation place from the classrooms that are used for accommodation. There are several showers and toilets at the campsite, but those are not with the accommodation rooms. Please leave your valuables home since there are not safe-deposits in the campsite. Classrooms in the leisure center can be a bit drafty, so please reserve warm clothes with you also for the nights. We have arranged mattresses and blankets for our foreign participants. You'll get them from the check-in.

ACCOMMODATION

The camp fee does not include accommodation (note the change from last year). The persons who are staying overnight at the campsite must pay accommodation fee.

The accommodation fee is 4 € / night / person.

Boogie Night 2006

Instruction

PERIODS The Boogie Night dance camp is divided into three two-day periods. The three periods together form the six day dance camp:

1. Tuesday - Wednesday 27. – 28.12.2005,
2. Thursday - Friday 29. - 30.12.2005 and
3. Saturday - Sunday 31.12.2005 - 1.1.2006.

At the first period you can select for your main dance: boogie woogie or lindy hop. For the last four days the main dance is boogie woogie. Both dances have several group levels. At the second period junior boogie woogie dancers take part to the camp also.

DAILY INSTRUCTION

There are selectable group lessons daily at 12.00 – 14.00. Group lessons with your own group level are daily at 14.30 – 16.30 or 15.00 – 17.00. In addition, there are taster-lessons daily at 9.00 – 11.00 and some special themes before night parties.

BEGINNERS CLASSES

At the first period (27. - 28.12.2005) a lindy hop beginners class is organized.
At the last period (31.12.2005 - 1.1.2006) a boogie woogie beginners class is organized.

BONBONS

In Boogie Night 2006 dance camp we have a variety of BonBons available. You can learn e.g. tango argentine, balboa, bugg, dubbel bugg, jive, rock'n'roll, salsa, shag, swing hop and many other dances.

CLASS FOR TEACHERS

This year we offer special training for rock'n'swing dance teachers. The lessons designed for teachers are instructed by camp teachers and they cover typical subjects for rock'n'swing dances from a teacher point of view.

There is one lesson for teachers on each period, which are included in the camp price. The lessons of teachers group are meant only for rock'n'swing dance teachers. Other camp participants are encouraged to follow the lessons comfortably from their seats. The enrollments to this group are at camp registration.

TIMETABLE

Preliminary timetable is attached to this info letter. Changes are still possible. The final timetable is seen on the dance camp notice board. Updated information can be found from the website.

- The main teaching language is English.
- Video recording is not allowed during the classes unless agreed with the teacher. It is encouraged, that the possible video recordings are done after each lesson – if agreed with the teacher.
- Participation is allowed only for your own group level (decided in the beginning of the camp by our foreign instructors), unless agreed with one of the camp bosses (Markku Rintala or Hanna-Reetta Lehto). Instructors and camp staff are allowed to remove inappropriate people from the lessons if necessary.

Group Levels

GROUP LEVELS

In the Boogie Night 2006 dance camp there will be group levels from 1 to 6 for boogie woogie during the periods 2 and 3. In addition, beginners group for boogie woogie is available during the last period.

During the first period there will be instruction in boogie woogie and lindy hop with group levels from 1 to 3. Also beginners group for lindy hop is available.

If you participate in the periods with different partners, you have to participate in the group division in the beginning of each period.

FORMING THE GROUP LEVELS

All the participants of the camp, excluding beginners, shall participate in the group division. Group levels are formed by our foreign instructors. Groups are formed with the following agenda:

All the dancers go to the floor at the same time. Music is played and the participants dance. Foreign instructors review the group and give the dancers their group level starting from level 6 (the most advanced level group).

At first the speed of the music will be around 48 - 52 bars/min and will get slower during the group division event. It's not worthwhile for couples that are not aiming at the most advanced levels to exhaust themselves at the beginning, but wait for the slower speeds until starting to dance.

Group division is not a competition between the couples. The purpose is to form as unified groups as possible for the lessons. The instructors are looking for you basic technique, rhythm, and bounce etc; you don't have to show your most difficult figures at this point.

Partner rotation

There will be partner rotation in most of the lessons of the Boogie Night 2006 dance camp. Instructors take care of the rotation.

When changing partner, you have to pay attention to your leading and following, which helps you to develop those skills. You'll also meet different people and get more views to your dance, not to mention the friendship and relationships e.g. for the Night Parties.

Participation to the partner rotation is voluntary. It's not necessary for learning. You can dance the whole camp with your own partner if you want. In that situation you can just politely tell during the class that you won't participate in the partner rotation.

Boogie Night 2006

Evening programme

The parties in the dance camp are - some say - the most important and fascinating part of the whole camp! In Boogie Night 2006 there is a different kind of party every night. In the main hall the music is usually mostly rhythm'n'blues and swing. On Thursday evening there is a front-line Finnish rhythm'n'blues band playing live music.

The hot evenings of dance are spiced with shows and (joyful...) competitions! You shouldn't miss them! After the midnight the dancing people move downstairs into the Boogie Night Club, where dancers' own records are played until... you say when!

If you are not taking part to the camp in a particular day and want to join an evening party, a small entrance fee is charged. Please contact us for details.

The First Night, Tuesday 27.12.2005 – Get to know your campmates!

During the first night, DJ's from around Finland compete with each other, and you can vote for the best by dancing! The theme of the night is getting to know people, so go dance with new friends, not only with the ones you know already!

The Second Night, Wednesday 28.12.2005 – Down to the caves

You cannot get lower than this by dancing! After hunting the whole day all the Neanderthals gather together to cook some rock'n'swing soup of the prey of the day in the labyrinth of ancient caves.

Dress code: Get the oldest cloths you can find, preferably from the Neanderthal days.

The Third Night, Thursday 29.12.2005 – Band!

There is live music in the third night: the mighty rhythm'n'blues band Atomic Boogie Band gives us a good show!

The Fourth Night, Friday 30.12.2005 – Competition

On Friday evening, there is a competition in rock'n'swing dances. There are several dances with different classes, and everyone can take part. Please join the competition or follow it amongst the audience.

The ticket to the audience is included in the camp fee. Competitors have a separate participation fee.

The Fifth Night, Saturday 31.12.2005 – New Year's Party!

The New Year is met with style: Swing-polonaise guides us into the glamorous New Year's party, spiced with a cabaret. Bring your own show with you, and perform it in the cabaret!

Eating

The meals that you have reserved during registration are paid during the check in.

BREAKFAST Breakfast is served between 8.00 and 10.00 each morning. Breakfast includes porridge, corn flakes, yogurt, bread, margarine/butter, sausage/cheese, vegetables/fruits, coffee, tea, milk, juice

DINNER Dinner will be served at 16.30 – 18.30.

Menu: (Note! The menu is preliminary and can still change)

- Tuesday: Chicken and macaroni casserole with cheese and vegetables, green salad
- Wednesday: Fish soup/frankfurter soup, cheese, curd cheese dessert
- Thursday: Lasagna, green salad, grated carrots, flavored cucumber
- Friday: Meatballs, potatoes, sauce, green salad, fruit salad
- Saturday: Frankfurters, mashed potatoes, green salad, macaroni salad
- Sunday: Meat with red wine sauce, potatoes with cheese, green salad, berry soup

In addition there will be bread, butter/margarine, milk, juice and water.

CAFETERIA There is a cafeteria in the campsite, where you can buy snacks and refreshments. The cafeteria is open mostly during the breaks and night parties. Opening hours can be seen in the notice board of the camp.

OTHER The campsite is located in the middle of Hervanta, next to a shopping center. There are several shops and restaurants and cash stations nearby the campsite. There is a microwave oven for your use, but no fridge.

What to bring with you?

SHOES There are several kinds of floor materials in the dancehalls. Most of them are suitably slippery for dancing, but there are also lessons in a classroom that has a plastic floor. Pack your bag with several types of dancing shoes, for different types of floor materials. It's also good to have several shoes to help your feet get through the whole camp. Shoes must be suitable for indoors usage and they must not leave any marks to the floor.

Reserve also shoes for inside usage when you are staying at the campsite.

CLOTHES There will not be washing machine at the campsite, so bring enough clothes with you. Good training clothes are easy to wear. It's good to reserve different clothes for Night Parties, and please note the special clothes for the cave party. During some of the earlier camps there has been very cold weather in Finland, up to minus 30 degrees, so bring enough warm clothes, also for nights.

FOR CLASSES Bring your own refillable water bottle with you for lessons. The tap water is completely pure and drinkable. Also a small towel is useful. Add also pen and paper to your bag for making your own notes. Most importantly, bring your willingness to learn, enthusiasm and attitude with you.

FOR THE NIGHT At the campsite, mattresses and blankets are reserved for foreigners. Bring your own sheets!

Accommodation

There is a possibility to accommodate at the campsite during the camp. The floor-level accommodation at the campsite costs 4 € / night / person. There are different sizes of rooms reserved for accommodation, from approx. 8 up to 30 persons.

HOTEL HOUSING

Hotel Hermica, which is located near the campsite, offers hotel rooms at the price 50 € / night / room. The maximum number of persons per room is three. However, the restaurant at the hotel is not open during the camp.
